
- Youth Leader: Katrina Semones




# Beginner Beekeeping Class of 2020



- MBA uses Cash Method of accounting.

  Transactions are booked when money is received or paid.
- <sup>1</sup> Venue
  - Normally, MBA would pay \$2,400 in Dec for the venue for the following year
    - MBA paid \$2,400 in Dec 2019 for 2020
  - MBA met 3 times in venue in 2020, then local gov't prohibited in-person meetings
  - MBA continued reservations for 2020, but when it was clear we would not meet again in person, we got refund of \$900
  - In Dec 2020, we did not pay for 2021, but will pay in 2021 when we can meet again
- · <sup>2</sup> Scholarships
  - The cost to MBA was reduced by Texas Bee
     Supply donating equip, suits, & tools
