

Suspect Bees Exposed to Pesticides? Report it.

Bees may be exposed to harmful pesticides:

- When foraging
- From in-hive products

Symptoms include:

- Dead or dying bees near hive or on plants
- Spinning, twitching, disoriented bees
- Regurgitation with an extended tongue
- Abnormal behavior

Immediately report suspected pesticide-related incidents in Texas **512-463-7622**

EPA uses reports to identify patterns of bee kills, to inform pesticide regulatory decisions.
